New Advanced Signs: 103,104 115, 121, 123

Intermediate students: The jump is not used in the Intermediate class. Replace that with a Novice sign #12, or any other Novice sign that is not a turn or a cone exercise.

Tips:

You cannot retry this sign if your dog refuses the jump on the first try. You may run to help your dog clear this jump.

Remember to ask the dog to “heel” **while he is in mid air** to remind him what he needs to do when he lands. The dog needs to adjust to you.

104 HALT - Turn Right One Step - Call to Heel - HALT – AKC Video: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=RXXFf-KJI8E>

Remember: The dog must stay sitting while the handler turns, takes one step to the right. It's a good practice to go back to your dog to reward for staying.

115 Halt - Stand – AKC Video: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=OoZ5rMnVn3E>

In the Intermediate and Advanced classes the handler may touch the dog to stand it. In the Excellent and Master classes the handler may not touch the dog to stand it.

121. HALT - Step in Front - Finish Right - Forward – AKC Video: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=6yMSTXBTI-4>

There is no halt on the finish. You must heel forward before your dog gets to heel position.

123. 2 Side Steps Right - Forward – AKC Demo: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=TnqYiN9W9qU>

When taking the two steps to the right, leading with your right foot, take the 2nd step to the right with your right foot too.

Help your dog know you will be doing this with extra commands to move with you. You can pat your leg in the Novice & Advanced classes, but not in the Excellent & Master classes.
