New Master Signs: 303, 304, 310, 311, 314

Tips:

303. HALT - Recall over Jump - Finish - About Turn - Forward - AKC Video:

You'll Halt at the sign, leave your dog, and go to the other side of the jump. Make sure you can see your dog between the stanchions before calling him to front to help him not go around the jump. There is a finish-forward. You may finish the dog in either direction.

304. Call Front - Move 2 Side Steps Right - AKC Video: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=pG6dXSctu4g

Some dogs have a problem not sitting while moving from the first front to the second front when you take two steps to the right. If your dog sits during this transition, just keep going. It is not an IP if the dog sits during this transition, just points off. This was discussed at a Judge's Seminar in January 2019 in Northern California.

The easiest way to remember which way to turn is to stick your left arm out to the left and follow that arm. Sounds silly, but it works and makes it easier for lots of students.

311. Backup 3 Steps - Stand & Leave - Call to Finish - Forward - AKC Video:

Just remember to begin this exercise at sign. You will end up at the Call sign, which will then be about 6 ft. away, to call your dog. Finish forward on this sign – no sit at finish.

You will always enter to the right side of cone #1. Make sure you cross the centers before attempting to go around #s 2, 3, &4. Exit will then be with cone #1 on your left.
