

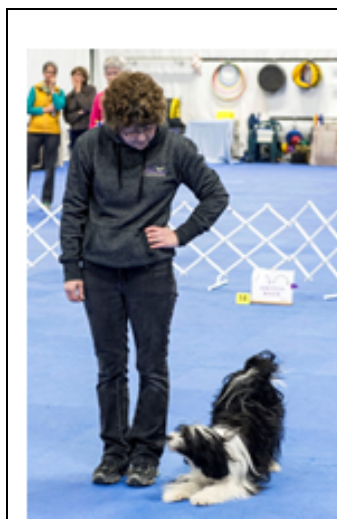

What is Rally-FrEe?

Rally-FrEe is a unique sport combining the trick behaviors of Canine Musical Freestyle with the format of Rally-Obedience. Courses are laid out that direct the dog and handler around the ring, performing moves such as leg weaves, spins, backing up, paw lifts, and bows. Dogs learn to work at all four of the handler's sides: left, right, front, and behind. The sport emphasizes the precise execution of fundamental freestyle and obedience skills while encouraging creative and novel “free choice” behaviors.

What to expect:

This 2 hour clinic will introduce you to the rules and format of Rally-FrEe. We will review the Novice level signs and some of the advanced ones. Working Teams will work on-leash and will have a chance to practice the fundamental skills most important to Rally-FrEe. Advanced teams will be given higher-level exercises.
