New Advanced Signs: 107,110,111,113,117.

Intermediate students: The jump is not used in the Intermediate class. Replace that with a Novice sign #12, or any other Novice sign that is not a turn or a cone exercise.

107. HALT – 90° Pivot Left – HALT – AKC Video: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=5n5ElyuovHo>

Don't forget, a pivot is turning in the circle occupied by the handler before they started the turn; a turn in place. Your dog MUST heel with you as you pivot.

110. HALT – Call Front – Finish Right – AKC Video: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ZUwqUxIzd_I

In this video can you find something wrong? If you can, let me know. I'll let you know tomorrow.

This is the same as #111 above, except the dog will finish to the right.

In this video can you find something wrong? If you can, let me know. I'll let you know tomorrow.

The first thing the team will do is HALT and the dog sits. From then on, the Handler cannot move her feet (even for the finish) until they continue to the next sign.

113. HALT – 180° Pivot left – HALT – AKC Video: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=gx92yWrtFoA>

Make sure your feet are in the same place after the pivot. Your dog MUST heel with you as you pivot. Make sure both feet are facing the new direction before you step forward. If your dog can pivot on a bowl counter-clockwise, he's got this pivot down. If not, practice this pivot so your dog can learn to move his back feet independently of his front feet. Here's a good video to watch how it is taught. <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=jHpikko8h0s&feature=youtu.be>. Before doing this, the dog needs to be shaped to want to put his front feet on the bowl.
